# How to post about WeForest



## **Make sure you're talking about growing trees or restoring hectares/square meters of forests**

Our projects restore forests using several restoration methods (we do a lot more than planting trees).

## **Make it visual**

Don't hesitate to add our logo and yours as well to the pictures on your post to make it more entertaining.

## **Give the most accurate explanation**

Talking about the project you're supporting and especially about your goals makes it more personal and could inspire others to get involved in forest restoration as well.

## **Ask for reviews**

Our team is always connected and can help by reviewing the content you're planning to post.

We'll be delighted to like and comment your posts on our different channels




# What is the right language to use?

Most of our projects are not only planting projects; they focus on forest restoration, and use a combination of different approaches, whichever is most effective to achieve healthy, thriving forests. 
# Example Posts - Instagram




## Why are these posts great?

- Be authentic and transparent to your audience






